Stuart and Jenny Clatworthy farm on the beautiful Somerset Levels, producing both lambs and beef cattle for Bakers of Nailsea.



Stuart is now the sixth generation of his family to be farming the family farm, which he hopes his son Percy will also want to continue farming in the future. Stuart lets his cattle and sheep graze extensively on the farm as much as possible, whilst the weather and seasons permit. The cattle are offered a small amount of homegrown barley each day to allow Stuart to check them over to ensure they are in the best of health. With the sheep Stuart is able to quietly walk round them to check they are all happy and healthy.

“We are very lucky to have our farm on the Somerset Levels and the best way to farm it is to let the cattle and sheep graze as much as possible. There are occasions when they require something more than just grass, but these occasions are kept to a minimum.”
